What is Your Name?

Names are important. A person's name is how we identify them, it is what makes them feel known. When a returning guest enters our church or bible fellowship, if you can call them by name, they feel that you care because you took the time to remember their name. Learning names is a small, but significant gesture.

Do you prefer to get a letter in the mail addressed to "Dear Resident" or to your name? Names are important because they move a person from the category of unknown or a number, to a person who matters. Sometimes, as believers, we begin to see the world as lost numbers to be saved, rather than people who God knows by name. Rather than how many, we should ask "who did you meet?" Knowing their name demonstrates value. Do you make a conscious effort to know the names of the people in your church family?



In Genesis 32, Jacob has a powerful encounter with God. Jacob was alone for the night, anticipating his meeting the next day with his estranged brother, Esau. That night, Jacob wrestled with a man that we later learn is God. Early in the morning, Jacob asked of the man he was wrestling with to bless him.

The man asked Jacob "What is your name?" To which, he replied, "Jacob." Then the man with whom he was wrestling said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel, because you have struggled with God and with men and have overcome." Jacob received a new name that was given to him because it identified the characteristic of perseverance. Jacob was a warrior, an over-comer, one who did not give up easily in the struggle of life.

What if God were to give you a new name based on the characteristics of your life and service to Him, what would that name be? As a part of the family of God and WBBC, live life in a way that honors God.



"Make your own attitude that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be used for His own advantage. Instead He emptied Himself by assuming the form of a slave, taking on the likeness of men. And when He had come as a man in His external form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death even to death on a cross.

For this reason God also highly exalted Him and gave Him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Philippians 2:5-11
